Now that I have access to Epic, why should I continue to log in to the HIE?

The information below is available in the HIE but NOT in Epic:

- Results, Encounters, and Continuity of Care Documents (CCDs) from Hoag Urgent Care, St. Joseph Heritage Medical Group, and the following hospitals: St. Joseph, St. Jude, and Mission
 - Continuity of Care Documents (CCDs) from 1,000 community providers
- Reference lab data from 2,000 community providers using LabCorp, Quest, NewPath, and WestPac Labs
- Outpatient visit notes from St. Joseph Heritage Medical Group
- GI Reports from Hoag Endoscopy Center, Newport Beach Orange Coast Endoscopy Center, and Irvine Endoscopy Partners
