



What the new Hoag-enabled Health Information Exchange (HIE) means for you.

When your doctor orders a test for you, HIE delivers the results safely and quickly, allowing for immediate follow-up if needed.

If you have an accident and are brought in to the emergency room unable to speak, your treating physician may access lifesaving information about your medical history through HIE, right there in the emergency room.

HIE tracks who has viewed your information, which keeps your records more secure than paper charts.

Why HIE?

Providing you with exceptional care has been Hoag's sole mission for nearly 60 years and counting. HIE comes from our core commitment to doing what's right for the communities we exist to serve.

Through HIE, participating providers will be able to access information about you that is necessary for your medical treatment, unless you choose to opt out and have your information withheld. If you feel that your medical information should not be available through HIE, Hoag will continue to use your medical information in accordance with the Notice of Privacy Practices and the law, but will not make it available to other health care providers through HIE.
